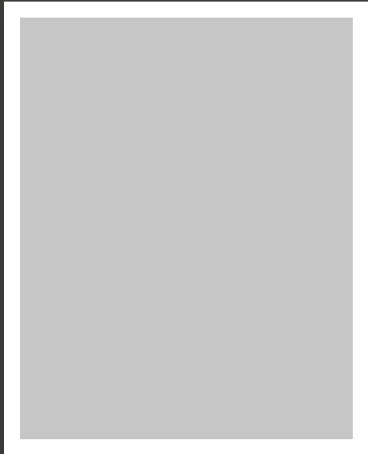


Elliott Nadel



At this writing Elliott has been active mainly in the 1-wall handball community for more than three decades.

He has participated in 1-, 3-, and 4-wall local, regional, and national tournaments, which have included small ball, pink ball, and big blue in various levels of play. He was introduced to the game in Coney Island before becoming a teenager. While in his teens he began volunteering his time to assist in running local tournaments. Later he joined the USHA 1-Wall Committee, which eventually led to his earning the role as the Committee's treasurer, and, ultimately, USHA 1-Wall Commissioner. During the 1990's Elliott, a quiet and modest man, was instrumental in running the annual USHA National 1-Wall Tournament, and thereby largely responsible for keeping organized 1-wall handball alive and healthy.
