

Bruce Davidoff*

Brother of National Hall of Fame player, Ken Davidoff, Bruce Davidoff, a product of Lincoln Terrace Park, proved to be one of the best young 1-wallers in New York City as a teenager.

As first singles player for Canarsie High School's Handball Team, he was feared among all other Public School Athletic League players. A hard-hitting right hander, Bruce combined speed, great stamina, and tremendous desire to win. This eventually enabled him to reach the singles semi-finals in three National Tournaments: twice in the AAU, 1968 and '70, and once in the USHA, 1973. Although mainly a singles player, he also reached the semis of the 1973 USHA National Doubles event. Bruce's career as an open player spanned approximately ten years, from the middle 1960's to the middle 1970's.
