Ken Holmes was a power-hitting young man in high school. In 1960 he led Brooklyn's Midwood High to the coveted City Championship.

That same year he placed second in the city to Winfield Ballance in the challenging Mirror Parks Department Tournament. In 1965, teamed with National Hall of Famer Wally Ulbrich he was National USHA Doubles Champion. In 1966 he was a National USHA singles semi-finalist, and that same year, teamed again with Wally Ulbrich, he was A-1 National Doubles Champion. In '67 he was again among the top four singles players in the USHA National 1-Wall Singles event.
