Fred Munsch

From the middle 1970's through most of the '80's Fred was one of the dominant 4-wall doubles players in Metro NYC.

Partnered with National Hall of Fame player Joel Wisotsky, Fred won many regional and local tournaments during that lengthy stretch of time. Moreover, during the same time period, he won numerous masters events as well. If Joel and Fred did not win the tournament they entered, they would lose only in the finals to one of the few other outstanding teams of the era. Fred made the open finals in National 3-Wall two years in a row, and made the semis in that event on three other occasions. He won the National Masters 3-Wall six times. Broad shouldered and muscular, built like a swimmer, Munsch was a powerhouse who could blast with the strongest of his time.
