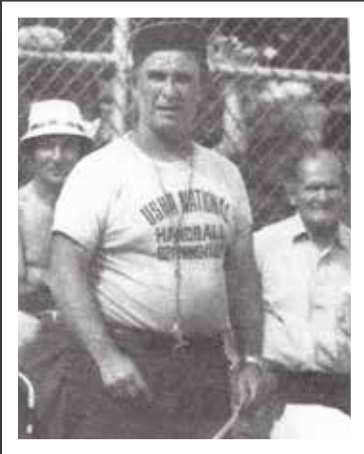


# Morris Levitsky – KA – 1991



**Morris Levitsky seemed a permanent fixture at West 5th Street in Coney Island. From the mid-1950's until the 1990's he would volunteer to referee games for local park players.**

He became increasingly adept at refereeing, and eventually became 1-wall's officially titled "Chief Referee." As his knowledge of the game and its players expanded, it was he who seeded the National AAU Tournaments. By 1968 he became Metropolitan AAU Handball Chairman, a position which he held until 1975 when the AAU could no longer accommodate handball, especially in light of the much more supportive USHA. Thereafter he served diligently on the USHA 1-Wall Committee for many years. There was literally no one who could referee a handball game or seed a tournament as effectively as Levitsky.
