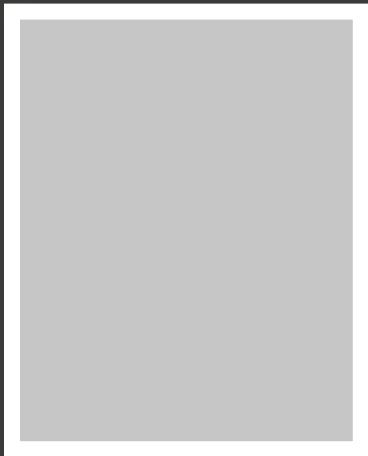


Larry Kadish



In the early 1980's Larry Kadish, father of strong doubles player Howie Kadish, purchased a building on West 27th Street and Surf Avenue because it house two regulation indoor 1-wall handball courts.

Larry allowed 1-wallers to use the courts free of charge often leaving a key with one of the players, trusting him to lock up after the night's activities were completed. The USHA National Indoor Tournament was held at West 27th from 1983 to 1988 with no rental charge. It was a donation from an avid handball lover, Larry Kadish.
