At this writing (2015) Sandy Ng seems destined to become one of the greatest women handball players ever. She won the USHA National Girls Junior 1-Wall Singles and Doubles events in 2008.

In 2009 she won the National USHA Junior 3-Wall Championship and made the semis in the National 1-Wall. In 2010 and 2011 she was National Women's 1-Wall Singles Champion, and second in that event in 2012. In 2010 she was also National 3-Wall Doubles champion. In 2011 she was National Doubles Champion in both 1-Wall and 3-Wall. She was runner-up in National 1-Wall Doubles in 2012 and 2013, and in 2014 she was National 1-Wall Doubles Champion. Her usual partner was Danielle Daskalakis.

In seven years of open handball competition, Sandy Ng has won seven National Championships.
