

Henry Herz

Henry Herz was among the best New York 4-wall players for nearly twenty years.

His first string showing came in 1933, when, with Larry Manka, he was runner-up in the Metropolitan AAU 4-Wall Doubles. His partnership with Manka endured for many years. In '34 they were Metropolitan AAU champions together. Twice Herz lost in local singles finals ('34 an '40) to National Hall of Famer Angelo Trulio, also a New Yorker. In '51 he place second with George Gluckler in a NYS AAU 4-Wall Doubles Tournament. In sum he was a champion three times and a runner-up five times.
