Artie Wolfe was, for a brief time, among the very top 1-wall players of the early 1940's.

His great hook serve, chief weapon in his arsenal, earned him the National AAU 1-Wall Singles title in 1941, the same year he was National AAU 1-Wall Doubles Runner-up. In '41 he also won the Metropolitan AAU 1-Wall Singles event. In '42 he reached the semis in National AAU play. In 1948, once again, he rose to the very top of the 1-wall game with a championship in the National AAU Doubles Tournament.
